Dear Sir, I would like to express my concerns about the expansion of the site at Greendale in the centre of East Devon. My wife and I have lived in Woodbury Salterton for almost 35 years and during this time we have seen the significant development of the site there often, I understand, without the appropriate planning permission being applied for beforehand. The continual development increases the noise to the area, traffic movements along our country lanes and puts an impossible strain on this lovely part of East Devon. There are many other brown field sites around the eastern part of Exeter that could be utilised which would be more appropriate to any businesses which needed to expand.

I support the proposed changes to the Village Plan and in particular that VP05 and VP06 be included in their entirety. Strategy 7 of the East Devon Local Plan (Development in the Countryside) must not be removed from the policy.
