Dear Sirs,

I am writing to you about the Village Plan for Woodbury Salterton, my home for 26 years , and the recent Inspector's report on this.

I have watched with concern the increased expansion of Greendale and its detrimental effect on the village. I have been especially annoyed at how much development has been carried out without first obtaining planning permission , to which the rest of us are subject .

I was pleased that a qualified Inspector studied our village plan and that we had the benefit of her expert opinion . However I object then to anyone trying to alter or amend her findings and especially trying to remove Strategy 7 of the East Devon Local Plan , which I understand would then give a loophole for getting through further development.

I feel that we have had more than our fair share of industrial development in this village. Apart from Greendale being a blot on the rural landscape it has resulted in increased traffic on our narrow country lanes and has brought light and noise pollution to residents who live near the complex, thus causing them distress and devaluing their properties.

I support the Inspector's report and ask you to accept it WITH NO ALTERATIONS .
