I am writing to oppose the proposed removal of STRATEGY 7 OF THE EAST DEVON LOCAL PLAN (DEVELOPMENT IN THE COUNTRYSIDE) from planning policy. As a Woodbury Salterton resident my basic argument is that 'enough is enough' with regards to Greendale's expansion on the edge of the village on the basis that the huge proposed expansion of the industrial estate would mean it was no longer on the edge of the village but starting to encroach on the residential area.
