We write to express our grave concern and anger at the continuing proposals to enlarge the Greendale industrial Complex despite the opposition of the residents of surrounding villages and the Village Plan which has been drawn up to protect Woodbury Salterton from over development Within the recommendations there is one line that is imperative to this protection, viz

"strategy 7 of the East Devon Local Plan (Development in the Countryside" .

Removing this final sentence from the policy will provide a loophole for ALL planning applications by Greendale and any other developers which is evident from those who are intent on removing Greendale and/or this line from the policy for commercial reasons.
