I note with interest and concern attempts by some commercial organisations to have a specific reference removed from the the planning policy.

I would stress that:

“Strategy 7 of the East Devon Local Plan (Development in the Countryside) must not be removed from the policy”.

Should this be allowed then the considerable development at Greendale will just continue unabated and uncontrolled. There have already been instances of retrospective planning applications made where building work has been done before any applications have been made. The horrendous colours of the buildings at Greendale are already a blot on the landscape, this will only get worse. As will of course the additional traffic movements. Even now we see large commercial vehicles trying to access the site by means other than by the recommended routes and in consequence tearing up the verges and lanes.
