I am a resident of Woodbury Salterton and have been for nearly 40 years during which time I have witnessed huge changes to the countryside environment close to the village, with an increase in heavy traffic, noise and commuter traffic in the narrow lanes leading to the village as a result of the industrialisation of Greendale Industrial Estate.

I support Strategy 7 of the EDDC plan (Development in the Countryside) and particularly clauses VP05 and VP06 which must be retained in order to help protect the open countryside. The need to provide employment land has more than been fulfilled and no more expansion should be allowed whatsoever in order to protect the environment. I recently had cause to speak to two different people who were employed by different firms at Greendale, one told me he travelled up from Plymouth the other down from Bridgewater, on a daily basis.
