Dear Sirs

I am sending this message to voice my objections to the clause in the East Devon Villages Plan that allows up to 15 houses to be built “by exception” outside the village boundaries. It has been ascertained that there is no need for additional housing in East Budleigh, but, despite this, permission has already been given to build on land below Syon House which is Class 1 Agricultural Land and AONB.

The intention of The Neighbourhood Plans is to ensure that local residents have a say and influence in deciding the future of their villages, and many of these residents have invested a very large amount of time and effort in preparing the East Budleigh Neighbourhood Plan.

To insert this “by exception” clause in the Neighbourhood Plan negates the thoughts and wishes of the residents and the efforts of all those who prepared the Plan and takes any decision out of their hands.
