Subject: East Devon Villages Plan Main Modifications Consultation

I am very concerned about the attempt to water down the East Devon Villages Plan by removing references to the Greendale and Hill Barton Business Parks.

Specifically, I strongly request that all references to Policies VP04 and VP05 and references to Strategy 7, Development in the Countryside, in the East Devon Local Plan to be included, in full.

The residents of Woodbury Salterton and the surrounding area, need the security of knowing the full extent of the Employment Boundary and the limits for future development. They are already suffering from the effects of previous expansions (often constructed without pre-approval of the planning Authority) with increased heavy goods traffic, vehicle damage to property, noise and other forms of pollution. Any further expansion will exacerbate these problems and further reduce the quality of life the in the village and clash with the amenity provided by this area.
