3. If any election is contested the poll will take place on Thursday, 11th April 2024 between the hours of 7am and 10pm.

5. Applications, amendments or cancellations of postal votes must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Blackdown House, Border Road, Honiton, EX14 1EJ by 5 pm on Monday, 25th March 2024.
