East Devon Local Plan and CIL Examination

I am pleased to advise that the Council has published papers for Development Management Committee on the 23 March and Council on 26 March in respect of proposed changes to the East Devon Local Plan. Subject to member approval we would hope to start consultation on proposed plan changes, to run for a six week period, in late March/early April.

As part of this consultation it would be highly desirable for you to set specific questions to be asked and if it were possible, in the time available, we would be keen to advise members at committee of the questions. I therefore felt it would be timely to send you links to the committee paper, proposed changes to the plan and also to evidence documents supporting plan changes.
