Dear Mr Thickett

Thank you for your email regarding consultation on changes put forward at July hearing sessions of the East Devon Local Plan. To ensure clarity of understanding we will not be consulting on changes made in 2014 nor those dated March 2015. The relevant changes for consultation are, therefore, only those contained in the document at:

and specifically the table starting at page 18 - Schedule of Proposed Changes to the East Devon Local Plan – July 2015.

We are produced an amended version of this table stripping out the 'subject matter' and 'reason for proposed change' columns and inserted a new column giving each change a unique change reference number and will be inserting a page number column and amend presentation of changes, new text, to be shown in black underlined text. The changes schedule should be read alongside the draft of the plan at:

We will insert text to make it clear that consultation responses are only sought on the schedule of further changes (including one amended map) and not on the original text or earlier proposed changes.

For your information I attach a draft audit trail of various past versions of the plan and of previous and the new consultation.

On the basis of the above amendments we would wish to start the consultation on Friday 16th October 2015 and run it for a six week period to conclude at 12.00 noon on Monday 30 November 2015. We would aim to send all representations to you in the week starting the 30 November 2015 and at the same time to also have them available on our website.

I should be obliged if you could confirm that the above will meet your requirements and it would also be helpful if you could advise of possible future work and timetables after consultation has concluded. I suspect we will be receiving queries about the stages of work after consultation has finished and it would be useful to have an outline of future possible steps to report on and also to inform our future work plans.
