### **Gypsy and Traveller Development Plan Document (DPD)**

East Devon District Council are consulting on three matters relating to the Gypsy and Traveller Plan and welcome your comments to be received by 5pm on 4<sup>th</sup> January 2016.

1. We would like to invite landowners to submit details of sites within their ownership which they feel are suitable, and available, for Gypsy and Traveller accommodation using the form. Sites will be assessed using a process set out in the Site Assessment Methodology with a view to allocating the most suitable sites in the Gypsy and Traveller Plan.
2. We would like your views on the process and criteria set out in the draft Site Assessment Methodology. It is intended that this document (subject to any revisions arising from the consultation) will be used to assess the sites submitted for consideration for Gypsy and Traveller accommodation.
3. We would like your views on the Sustainability Appraisal (SA) and Strategic Environmental Assessment (SEA) Scoping Report relating to the Gypsy and Traveller Plan.

The replies we receive will help us identify suitable sites for allocation for Gypsy and Traveller accommodation use.
