## Brief Project Descriptions

The following project descriptions have been paraphrased from each applicant's application:

### 3 County Tyres

Our project is the creation of an additional space for the business by means of a detachable and removable reception area.

### Rye Smile Caricatures

My project will revolutionise my business from a travelling caricature artist (using marker pens and paper) to a home based digital art illustrator.

### Castlewood Vineyards

Our project is to purchase the equipment needed to press our own grapes and provide a service for neighbouring smaller scale vineyards.

### Hook Farm Leisure Park

Our project is to install a water collection and treatment system that collects ground spring water, stores this water, treats the water so that we can use it for the showers and toilet flushing.

### Grace Safety & Compliance

We are proposing to develop a modular, blended, bespoke training package for aviation staff.

**DaffyDownDilly Confectioners**

Our project is to purchase a packing machine and heat sealing machine to further develop our confectionery business.

**HydroSurv Unmanned Survey**

Our project is the development of a Remote Operations Centre (ROC), a land-based facility where human operators maintain watchkeeping over USV (Uncrewed Surface Vehicle) marine platforms.

**Bar Buoy**

Our project is to diversify by selling our products at food and drink festivals.

**Powderkeg Brewery (with Big Drop Brewing Company)**

Our project is to install an in-house canning line at Powderkeg. If successful, Big Drop will immediately increase volumes commissioned from Powderkeg for both brewing and packaging.

**Safeguard Fire**

Our project will enhance the training and fully equip six staff to JOIFF Certified Industrial Firefighters.

**Jurassic Physio**

Our project is to diversify Jurassic Physio by creating a game-changing, digital branded exercise platform, aimed at the East Devon 65+ community.

**Community Waffle House**

Our project is to create a community-centred, alcohol free music hub in the centre of Axminster.

**Unique Boutique**

My project is to diversify to offer online sales alongside my physical shop presence.

**Theta Technologies**

Our project is the launch of a world-first product that will rapidly test and identify 'good' and 'bad' components in high-tech materials.

**Framing Excellent**

Our project is to purchase a computerised mount cutter (CMC) and ancillary equipment, for our bespoke picture framing business.

Our project is to produce our own bag-in-box ciders from premises in the Honiton area.

Our project is to develop a fully tested hardware product to rebuild our software platform.

Our project is to create a new learning experience that will encompass new photography skills and traditional printing methods.
