Thank you for seeking comments from the Blackdown Hills AONB Partnership regarding this revised Strategy. We welcome the opportunity to contribute further to the development of the strategy, and once again our comments are confined to Site H4, the Former Showground.

We would request that the comments submitted previously remain paramount as the strategy is developed further and implemented, and in the consideration of any future allocation or application at the Former Showground site.

It is noted that the description of the proposed facilities has been altered to changing facilities rather than clubhouse, and we believe that this is a welcome move if it indicates a simpler, more low key building/facility. We also welcome the indication that this site would be developed in way that it remains ancillary to the main site at All Hallows. We would also highlight again that provision of safe pedestrian and cycle access to the site may in itself have a detrimental urbanising effect on the AONB, and so this aspect needs consideration in its own right.

We would of course be very happy to discuss any points further in due course.
