I list my objections below:

- 1). Games would be played just a few feet away from the church door during Sunday morning mass times.
- 2) The noise & disruption would disturb Sunday services & also weddings, baptisms & funerals.
- 3). Playing fields would destroy & defeat the whole purpose of the quiet environment of St Rita's Retreat Centre as a place of peace & tranquillity.
- 4). There are no parking facilities to meet the extra influx of people.
