

NEIGHBOURHOOD PLAN

The Basic Conditions Statement has been sent to Martin Parkes at the Community Council of Devon and he has confirmed he is happy with. He has advised the Neighbourhood Plan Steering Committee to go ahead and draft the Neighbourhood Plan on the basis of what they have already got so far.

Once drafted it will be sent to East Devon District Council for approval and if they are happy the plan will go out to the various statutory consultees who will comment on it.

The final Plan will have to go before a Planning Inspector for approval so it is important that everything is in place and correct before this happens.

Residents will still be to have a final say with a referendum to confirm acceptance of the Plan. .
