Dear Sirs

I write further to my earlier email in response to the Baxters Farm development brief.

I wish to draw to your attention our existing difficulties in regard to the village crossroad on the A358. We frequently witness "near misses" due to so many vehicles emerging from various directions that I believe you will need to consider the consequences of adding to this current situation if you developed the Baxters site which will considerably increase the traffic emerging onto the A358. At the moment between the Village Hall and Musbury garage there are vehicles emerging from 5 separate points all accelerating into the stream of traffic in both directions. In addition there are emerging farm vehicles from Gaye's Farm opposite the Village Hall. It would be madness to exacerbate this situation by allowing a Travellers site here too.
