Dear Payhembury Parishioner,

In common with many parish councils, we are currently working on a *Neighbourhood Development Plan*. The plan will outline a vision and planning policies for Payhembury parish up to 2031 and, once complete, will carry legal weight in the planning process.

This is very much 'our plan' and we are keen to hear from residents from the outset. A key part of the evidence base are your views which we'd like to collect, initially via this questionnaire. There will be further opportunities to engage with the process as we move forward. Finally, for the Neighbourhood Development Plan to carry weight in the planning process, parishioners will have an opportunity to vote for the plan in a referendum, which we hope might be in early 2018.

Whilst completing the form, please try to think about what is important not just for today, but also into the future (e.g. how do we maintain a thriving yet sustainable community, support the expanding school with a steady flow of new children, support older members of the community with services they require, etc.).

The Neighbourhood Development Plan is primarily concerned with land use, however the Parish Council would also like to gain views on other topics, hence the questions about transport and broadband.
