Thank you for giving the parish council the opportunity to comment on this document.

There are a couple of typographical errors:

Page 29, 6<sup>th</sup> bullet point – it should be “West Hill woodland village”, not “West End woodland village”.

Page 30, Future forces for change, last bullet point – again should be “West Hill”, not “West End”.

We note with concern that potential expansion of West Hill is noted as a future force for change, but appreciate that this will be addressed through GESP and Local Plan reviews.

We support the comment on Page 31, last but one bullet point, that the Plan should include “Retain the treed character of West Hill village and ensure it remains screened through tree planting.”
