



## **Statement of Representation Procedure and Availability of Documents**

Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 (as amended)

The Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012 (as amended), regulation 19: Publication of a Local Plan

### **Title of Document**

The Cranbrook Plan

### **Proposed subject matter and proposed area**

The Cranbrook Plan should be read alongside the East Devon Local Plan 2013 – 2031, which was adopted in January 2016 and sets the planning strategy for East Devon. The Cranbrook Plan allocates land for the expansion of Cranbrook alongside strategic policies to further define that development and ensure that appropriate Habitat Mitigation is delivered at Cranbrook. 'Built-up Area Boundaries' for the settlements of Cranbrook and Broadclyst Station are defined. The Cranbrook Plan also includes policies on town centre development at Cranbrook, commercial development on London Road (B3174) within the boundaries of Cranbrook and the restoration of Tillhouse Farm, a listed building within Cranbrook.

### **Period of publication for representations**

Representation must be received by East Devon District Council no later than 5pm on Wednesday 24 April 2019. All representations will be treated as public documents and will be published on the Council's website. The representations will be submitted to the Secretary of State and considered as part of a public examination by an independent Planning Inspector.

### **Where to view the documents**

If you are objecting to the proposed submission Cranbrook Plan and wish to speak at the examination, it is imperative that you make this clear on your representation form. You may request that we notify you of: when the plan is submitted for examination; when the Inspectors recommendations are published; when the plan is adopted and/or any other planning policy issues.
