Hi Claire

Can I ask you to raise the issue at the DM Cmtee and/or ask another member to do so.

From a very quick view of the inset map and boundary for Alfington it would not cause me any real concern if the boundary were retained, though I have not given it detailed consideration (I will ask Claire Rodway to have a look). The absence of a boundary would/should not stop planning approval for play and other community facilities. Though if facilities could only be secured/provided in association with other developments, eg houses, then this might mean no scheme comes forward.

The problem I would have with making a change of this nature to the plan at this stage is that it was/has not been endorsed by the Panel. In procedural terms I think this is/should have been the appropriate course of action. I strongly suspect the Panel would have endorsed such a change, but the matter was not raised.
