Development Areas in Whimpe.

I object to any further development in Whimpe because there is no infrastructure to support further housing.

The road into Whimpe is already very busy and having to go past the church to the school etc is already problematic. If this road is closed for any reason the other roads are barely poorly maintained lanes.

The school has no room for expansion and is already full to capacity. The school surgery has already many more pupils because of expansion in other surrounding areas + further development in Whimpe would compound the issue.

More houses especially around the green are likely to cause more flooding.

As Cranbrook has already had 500 homes approved at however when I cannot see the need for Whimpe to expand.

It is essential to keep a green belt between Cranbrook + Whimpe and to keep the environment maintaining hedges + fields to keep up the wildlife.
