Development Areas in Whimple -

I object to any further development in Whimple because there is no infrastructure to support further housing.

The road into Whimple is already very busy and having to go past the church to the school etc is already problematic if this road is closed for any reason the other roads are pretty poorly maintained banks.

The school has no room for expansion and is already full to capacity. The decision surgery has already many more points to come of expansion in Ottery & Cranbrook so further development in Whimple would compound the issue.

More houses especially around the green one likely to cause more flooding.
