Regulations 1984

The County of Devon (North and East Devon Area of Special Control of Advertisements) Order: Proposed Modification 1986

WHEREAS

- (1) The East Devon District Council (hereinafter called "the Council") as Local Planning Authority have considered whether the County of Devon (North and East Devon Area of Special Control of Advertisements) Order should be modified in respect of land at Exmouth in accordance with Regulation 26 of the Town and Country Planning (Control of Advertisements) Regulations 1984.
- (2) The Council have decided that all those parts of Exmouth specified in the First Schedule hereto should be removed from the area.

NOW THEREFORE the Council in pursuance of the powers conferred upon them by Section 63 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971 and the said regulation 26.

DO HEREBY ORDER

1. That all those parts of Exmouth specified in the First Schedule hereto and shown on the map lettered "A" annexed hereto in black hatching and coloured yellow shall be removed from the Area of Special Control for the purpose of the said regulations.
2. That this Order may be cited as The County of Devon (North and East Devon Area of Special Control of Advertisements) Modification Order 1986.

THE FIRST SCHEDULE

1. Land at Exmouth developed or allocated on the approved Exmouth and Lympstone Town Map First Review for residential industrial or public open space purposes but excluding areas allocated for residential or public open space purposes at Foxholes and Littleham which lie within the East Devon Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty
