Subject: Affordable housing

Affordable housing (which is actually subsidised housing by definition) should be confined to areas where people can get to work by public transport.

If people can afford cars they should not be benefitted by subsidised housing.

Subsidised housing should only go to people in need, and people who are genuinely in need (such as elderly people who have nothing but the state pension) cannot afford cars, so subsidised housing needs to be near buses and shops.
