This statement must be signed by two members of the society who are appointed for the purpose in writing by the society, or if it has one, it's governing body. These persons must be an adult. A copy of the written appointment MUST be included with this statement.

NOTES

Returns are required by law and must be submitted not later than the end of the third month after the date of the draw.

Any person who fails to send a return, or who knowingly gives false information, or who certifies any return knowing it to contain false information shall be guilty of an offence and it liable to prosecution by the Local Authority, police of the Gambling Commission. A person found guilty of an offence shall be liable to conviction of:

- A. Imprisonment for a term not exceeding 51 weeks
- B. A fine not exceeding level 5 on the standard scale, or
- C. Both

YOUR LOTTERY MAY BE SUBJECT OF INVESTIGATION FOR

- Making a late return of a statement following the holding of a lottery
- Making no returns at all within a year of registration
- Failure to pay the annual fee as it becomes due
- Reports of sales of lottery tickets by persons under the age of sixteen
- Reports of sales of lottery tickets to persons under the age of sixteen
- Reports of societies running lotteries without holding registration
- Indications that the society has breached permissible limits
- Reports of misappropriation of funds.

The following would be likely to affect your status

- Submission of late (must be submitted no later than three months after the date on which the lottery was held)
- Submission of incomplete or incorrect returns; and breaches of the limits for small society lotteries

Otherwise your personal information will not be disclosed to anybody outside East Devon District Council without your permission, unless there is a lawful reason to do so, for example disclosure is necessary for crime prevention or detection purposes. Your information will be held securely and will not be retained for any longer than is necessary.
