Thank you for giving us the opportunity to comment. I have had a look through the consultation document but don't have time or the expertise to respond in detail.

My suggestion for Budleigh Salterton and other towns is that they need Smartening Up. In my opinion this should be paid for in part by landlords. Most shops need a facelift and I imagine most flats need modernising. They should then be available as low cost housing to some of our young people. Smartened up shops, with lower rents, should attract in new business - shops and restaurants/ a wine bar. I'd also like to see some community facilities in the High Street (in place of Charity Shops which attract low budget visitors only).

My other priority would be for Budleigh Salterton to have its own Indoor Swimming Pool, at least 25 metres, to help the residents keep fit, at times when sea-bathing is not an option, without having to pollute the environment by driving to Exmouth or Woodbury.
