I live in the village of Rockbeare.

I am opposed to any expansion that crosses the old A30. This is what was originally promised by East Devon District Council, when selling the idea of Cranbrook to surrounding areas, this is also recorded in the Parish District Council Minutes to this effect.

Cranbrook was designed to sit harmoniously with neighbouring villages and settlements, not creep inexorably towards them, eventually absorbing them, which seems to be the current flow of things. Rockbeare village has suffered road closures out of our village, and bus services cancelled over the last 2 years because of building roundabouts, extension to the EON pipework, because this was not suitably adequate to cope with all the extra new housing, which seems to have crept up very secretly.

Enough is enough.

There is plenty of scope to further the town without encroaching on our side of the A30. Rockbeare is already losing its identity as a village with a green belt
