



# Luppitt Neighbourhood Development Plan INFORMATION STATEMENT Referendum: 24 November 2022

## Information Statement

A neighbourhood planning referendum will be held for the Luppitt Neighbourhood Development Plan on 24th November 2022.

The question asked in the referendum will be:

- **Do you want East Devon District Council to use the Neighbourhood Plan for the parish of Luppitt to help it decide planning applications in the neighbourhood area?"**

The referendum area for the Neighbourhood Plan is the parish area of Luppitt. This is also the area covered by the Neighbourhood Plan (the 'Neighbourhood Area'), as shown on the map overleaf.

A person is entitled to vote in the referendum if, on Thursday 24th November 2022,

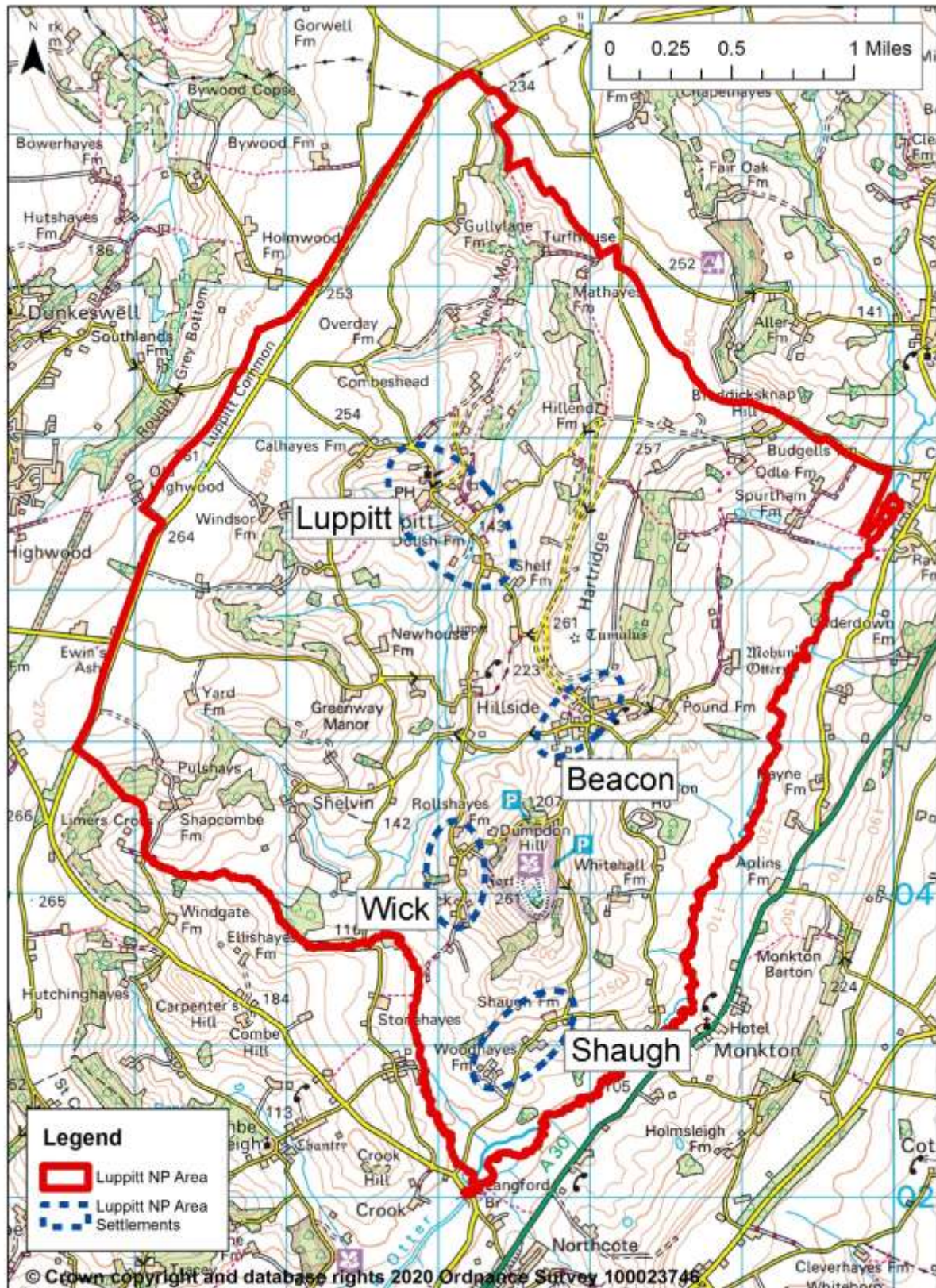
- he or she is entitled to vote in a local government election in the referendum area; and
- his or her qualifying address for the election is in the referendum area. A persons qualifying address is, in relation to a person registered in the register of electors, the address in respect of which he or she is entitled to be registered.

The referendum expenses limit that will apply in relation to the referendum is £2385.07.

The number of persons entitled to vote in the referendum by reference to which the limit has been calculated is 391.

The referendum will be conducted in accordance with procedures which are similar to those used at local government elections.
