### **Broadclyst Neighbourhood Plan Examination**

Question:

*Is work on the emerging Local Plan proceeding to the timetable set out in the published Local Development Scheme (April 2022)?*

Answer:

Yes, the new emerging Local Plan timetable is still running broadly to that set out in the Local Development Scheme (April 2022) as follows:

- Issues Consultation – completed in January 2021.
- Draft plan – consultation starting Autumn 2022 (commenced 7<sup>th</sup> November).
- Publication – consultation starts Autumn 2023.
- Submission – early 2024.
- Inspector's Hearings – 2024.
