Hello,

I have replied individually to some specific development proposals around Exmouth & Lymington via your website which I have to say isn't very user friendly.

However, there are some general comments which I wish to make.

1 I am not in favour of filling in the green spaces around our towns & villages & destroying their nature & character.

2 The A376 Exmouth to Exeter road is too busy as it is without additional cars which would result from these proposed developments. It's all very well to say that public transport would be used but people like the convenience of their own transport.

3 Exmouth doesn't have the infrastructure to support large scale development- schools have limited capacity & medical services are stretched. I couldn't even register a family member as a temporary patient because the surgery is full.

4 The least worst option as far as I can see would be your favoured new town Option 1 just south of the A30. It would keep the traffic off the A376. It would have its own infrastructure with schools etc & the benefit of accessibility to employment at The Science Park/ Airport etc

Although it saddens me greatly to see good agricultural land be sacrificed especially at uncertain times when we should be looking to be self sufficient in food & agriculture.
