Air Quality Management Area Order 2010

East Devon District Council ("the Council") is satisfied that as a result of its air quality review and assessment dated May 2007 the air quality objective for nitrogen dioxide (NO₂ annual mean) is not likely to be achieved as specified within the Air Quality (England) Regulations 2000 ("the Regulations") in the area described below for reasons of the current and projected levels of nitrogen dioxide which exceed the objective levels set by the Regulations.

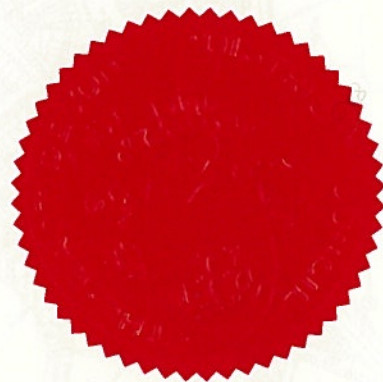
The Council, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by Section 83(1) of the Environment Act 1995, hereby makes the following Order.

1. This Order may be referred to as the East Devon District Council Air Quality Management Area Order 2010 and shall come into effect on the 1st day of January 2011.
2. The area shown on the attached map coloured yellow is designated as an Air Quality Management Area (hereinafter referred to as "the Designated Area". The Designated Area incorporates the Exeter A30 Exeter Road, A375 Exeter Road, A375 High Street, A35 Monkton Road and A35 Kings Road at 0 to 6.6 metres from the road centre line.
3. In the case of conflict between the wording of this order and the map, the map shall prevail.
4. This Order shall remain in force until it is varied or revoked by a subsequent order.

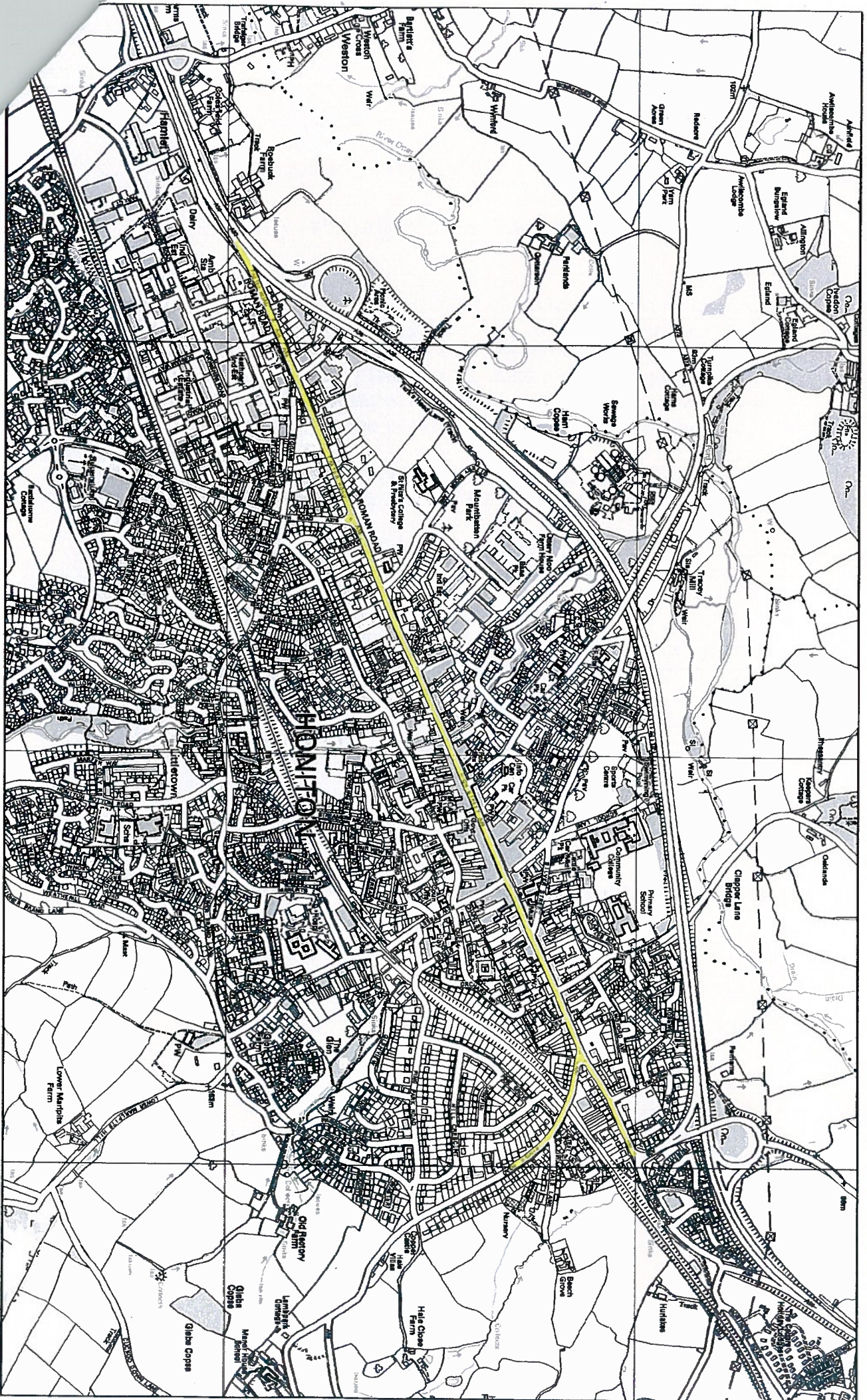
