




# The Regional Application Trend











# What do Government say

#### Processing and provision of planning data



"processing of planning data"

"setting data standards"

"data is held consistently and transmissible"

"provided digitally"

"approved data standards"

"excessive manual re-entry"

#### Data Processing

Power to enable the Secretary of State to regulate the processing of planning data by setting data standards to apply to the data produced and held by planning authorities.

This power is designed to ensure data is held consistently and transmissible through the planning system and can be easily reused for other purposes by third parties.

#### Provision

Power to enable planning authorities to require data arising from participants in the planning system to be provided digitally to them, in accordance with approved data standards, unless it would be unreasonable to expect a particular participant to do so.

The power is designed to ensure that local authorities are not overwhelmed by submissions in formats incompatible with data standards, resulting in excessive manual, re-entry of data.

#### Planning data to be made publicly available

#### **Publishing**

Power to require planning authorities to make certain planning data available to the public under an approved open licence.

This power is designed to ensure that the data held and created under the data standards power, is openly available and published for use by parties other than the planning authority and the Secretary of State. It is expected that the combination of the data standards and publication powers will result in information being provided in a consistent and more visual manner to the public by planning authorities.

#### Policy paper National Data Strategy

#### 3 Transforming government's use of data to drive efficiency and improve public services.

The coronavirus pandemic showed that there is massive untapped potential in the way government and public services use and share data to help and protect people. To sustain the high watermark set by the pandemic, the government will undertake an ambitious and radical transformation of its own approach, driving major improvements in the way information is efficiently managed, used and shared across government. To succeed, we need a whole-government approach that ensures alignment around the best practice and standards needed to drive value and insights from data; and the creation of an appropriately safeguarded, joined-up and interoperable data infrastructure to support this. We also need the right skills and leadership within the public sector to understand and unlock the potential of data.





- The fee is sent
















Instead of plotting your red line boundary externally to the Planning Portal, you will draw or upload the "location of your site" within the service









Planning Portal Location Plan








# Change application type when copying

- · Change the application type when copying existing applications,
- Also if you want to copy over supporting documents.
- This will be a major benefit if you have incorrectly stated the application type,
  as you will now be able to copy existing applications instead of starting their
  application again from scratch.
- Incorrect application type is one of the common reasons for applications getting rejected, and this should help reduce the number of such rejections.









# Change application type when copying

Planning is a collaborative process with numerous contributors to an application so we at the Planning Portal have developed Projects which sits at the heart of your Planning Portal account.






- Collaborate and share applications with colleagues

- Increased security and control of applications and accounts













- Only you as the account holder can see and work on applications on your page

- You no longer have to share accounts, log ins and passwords









- One person can create another add documents and edit and another check and submit







# Projects and Application Declaration

- An Agent or Applicant registers on the Planning Portal, this name will populate the declaration
- An account holder can share an application on Projects
- Whoever submits that application their name will appear on the declaration

# Application declaration To submit your planning application you must agree to the below declaration. I/We hereby apply for Prior Approval: Development for electronic communications network as described in the questions answered, details provided, and the accompanying plans/drawings and additional information. I/We confirm that, to the best of my/our knowledge, any facts stated are true and accurate and any opinions given are the genuine opinions of the person(s) giving them. I/We also accept that, in accordance with the Planning Portal's terms and conditions: Once submitted, this information will be made available to the Local Planning Authority and, once validated by them, be published as part of a public register and on the authority's website; Our system will automatically generate and send you emails in regard to the submission of this application.





# FAQs

**Q**-How many Projects can you have per Account?

**A**-You can only have one per Account but can be a member or multiple projects

**Q-** If a member of the project leaves and has there account deleted what happens to there applications that they have created ?

**A-**As long as there applications are in Projects they can still be worked on and submitted

# Other forthcoming changes Coming Soon

- Prepay Applications
  - Ability to pay or nominate at any point of the process
- Bulk Payment
  - For companies that do weekly BACS and payment runs
  - One payment for multiple applications
- Apple Pay and Android Pay

- Best option for site location selection (i.e. addresses for single buildings, grid references elsewhere)
- Limitations on when amendments can be made (i.e. not if an application is determined/withdrawn)
