



Woodbury Parish Neighbourhood Development Plan INFORMATION STATEMENT Referendum: Thursday 30 July 2026

Information Statement

A neighbourhood planning referendum will be held for the Woodbury Parish Neighbourhood Development Plan on Thursday 30 July 2026.

The question asked in the referendum will be:

- **Do you want East Devon District Council to use the Neighbourhood Plan for Woodbury Parish to help it decide planning applications in the neighbourhood area?"**

The referendum area for the Neighbourhood Plan is the entire parish of Woodbury, including the villages of Woodbury, Woodbury Salterton and Exton. This is also the area covered by the Neighbourhood Plan and is shown on the map overleaf.

A person is entitled to vote in the referendum if, on Thursday 30 July 2026:

- they are entitled to vote in a local government election in the referendum area; and
- their qualifying address for the election is in the referendum area. (A person's qualifying address, in relation to a person registered in the register of electors, is the address in respect of which they are entitled to be registered.)

The referendum expenses limit that will apply in relation to the referendum is £2518.20. The number of persons entitled to vote in the referendum by reference to which the limit has been calculated is 2648.

The referendum will be conducted in accordance with procedures which are similar to those used at local government elections.
