I should like to record my objections to the above development, for general housing.

In 2013 and 2015the area in question was deemed unsuitable for such development and listed as AONB and remain as farmland. Nothing has changed except the risk of flooding to lower proerties due to climate change.

What use is that title of AONB if it can be ignored so easily. Just an absolute waste of money!!

Honiton's infrastructure is quickly becoming impossible i.e. drainage, sewerage, overflowing schools, overwhelmed GP doctors, dental appointments unobtainable, car parks bursting at the seams etc.etc.
