Dear Planning Policy Makers

I object strongly to the inclusion of the sites to the North East of Exmouth (Exmo_04a, Lymp_09, Lymp_10, Lymp_14) in the Local Plan which are not sustainable. Instead plans to build a new community in the area north of Hill Barton should be accelerated and more housing sites identified in Exmouth within the town's existing Built Up Area Boundary.

I am particularly concerned for the Pebblebed Heaths with its rare plants and wildlife. Also the strain on the occupants of the proposed new homes, with no bus services, challenging access to doctors, dentists and education; not to mention the stress on drivers with the narrow roads locally, where increasing car numbers, large transport and massive agricultural vehicles struggle to negotiate turnings and roundabouts.

If we are all to lead constructive and positive lives then creating stressful, crammed living conditions is not the way forward.
