

To Strategic Planning (Emerging Local Plan Comments)

Re: Proposed site LP_HON_01

There is no direct vehicular access to this site, which can only be accessed by constructing roads through adjacent fields. According to the information put forward so far, it is currently suggested that access to these adjacent fields will be via Hayne Lane and Sidmouth Road respectively, but residents are concerned that the more obvious route into the field lying due west of LP_HON_01 is via Honeysuckle Drive (which has been the proposed route into this site in previous planning applications).

Honeysuckle Drive provides the only vehicular access to the 139 residential homes in Cypress Close, Bracken Close, Heather Close, Fern Close and Honeysuckle Drive itself. It is a narrow residential road, which includes a blind turn at its junction with Heather Close.

The attached is a copy of a petition (24 sheets in total) which has been signed by residents of 124 out of the 139 properties which would be affected, stating their opposition to any proposal which would extend Honeysuckle Drive in order to provide an access route to any proposed development.
