We object strongly to the inclusion of the sites to the North East of Exmouth (Exmo_04a, Lymp_09, Lymp_10, Lymp_14) in the Local Plan. Instead plans to build a new community in the area north of Hill Barton should be accelerated and more town centre sites in Exmouth be found.

This area is an important green area between Exmouth and Lympstone and the Pebblebed Heaths. Its development would be very damaging to wildlife (flora and fauna) and to the environment of the district.

The infrastructure in the area is very inadequate for a substantial population increase. The nearby roads are too narrow and there are no pavements for pedestrians. There are no nearby schools, no shops and no GP surgeries for a long distance.
