Good afternoon

We are contacting you as we strongly object to the inclusion of sites to the North East of Exmouth (Exmo\_04a, Lymp\_09, Lymp\_10 and Lymp\_14) in the local plan which are not sustainable. The local infrastructure is already under pressure and, with over 300 more homes being built at Goodmores, cannot cope with another 258 homes on top which could lead to another 500 cars on our busy local roads.

There's very little employment in Exmouth so these homes would be mainly used as commuter houses for Exeter.

Obviously with the River Exe to the west and the sea to the south, Exmouth can only expand to the north and east but without encroaching on to Woodbury Common, Lympstone or Budleigh Salterton, sooner or later we have to say enough is enough.
