

Publication of the outcome of a community governance review of Colyford

Between December 2021 and December 2022 a community governance review of Colyford was conducted. At its meeting on 5th December 2022, East Devon District Council's Cabinet considered recommendations in relation to that community governance review and made further recommendations to Full Council. At its meeting on the 7th December 2022, East Devon District Council resolved to create a new Parish Council for a new Parish of Colyford.

East Devon District Council specifically resolved the following:

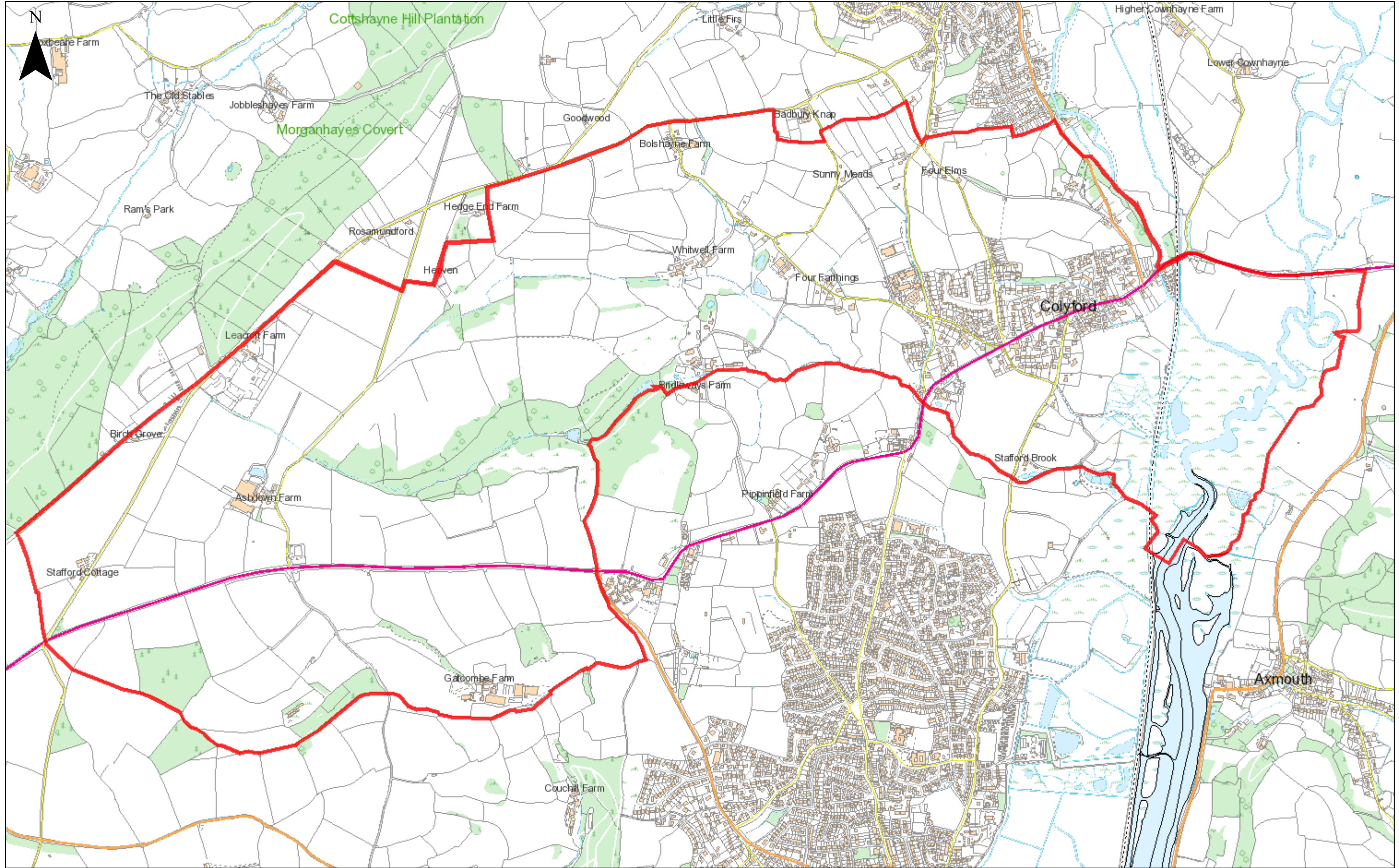
- That the new Parish Council be known as 'Colyford Parish Council'.
- The administrative boundary of Colyford Parish Council be as shown by the thick red line on the plan accompanying this notice.
- That the Membership of Colyford Parish Council will comprise of 7 councillors.
- That no warding provisions are incorporated in Colyford Parish Council.
- Colyford Parish Council will take effect from 1st April 2023 with Parish Council elections held in May 2023.

East Devon District Council also agreed to reduce the Members representing Colyton Parish Council from 13 to 11, also to take effect at the Parish Council elections in May 2023.

Reason: In accordance with the requirements of the Local Government and Public Involvement in Health Act 2007, and having had regard to the related statutory guidance, Members considered that it was appropriate to create a new Parish Council for Colyford as this reflects the identities and interests of the community in that area and would be effective and convenient.
