Sir/Ms. As a resident of Lympstone, I am horrified and scared at the proposal to build yet more houses in the vicinity of Exe View and Hulham Road. Horrified that the wonderful countryside in which I walk and relax is to be vandalised and scared that another - at least - 200 motor vehicles will be driving recklessly and without due regard to the safety of residents, young and old, at speeds at up to 60 mph, in Wotton Lane, known locally as the "rat run". Appointments with GP,s and hospital consultants, if obtainable at all, are being pushed inexorably into the future and with the difficulty with recruitment and retention, matters can only get worst with the influx of hundreds of extra people. People demand services and, as the Leader of Devon County Council has recently emphasised, those services have never been under greater strain.
