Subject: Objection to further Exmouth development

To whom it may concern

I object strongly to the inclusion of the sites to the North East of Exmouth (Exmo_04a, Lymp_09, Lymp_10, Lymp_14) in the Local Plan which are not sustainable. Instead plans to build a new community in the area north of Hill Barton should be accelerated and to find more town centre sites in Exmouth. Our secondary school is already one of the biggest in the country and it is impossible for staff to get to know individual students as it is. Students fall through the gaps and this can only get worse unless a second senior school is also provided with the development.

There are no NHS dentists with availability in Exmouth and doctors surgeries are already under pressure. Traffic jams in and out of Exmouth are already an issue, even before this new influx of commuters.

I hope you will consider other options rather than saturating Exmouth.
