Please be as precise as possible.: The way World Heritage Site's are managed includes the use of existing designation to provide a legal framework for Site protection. This is especially relevant because World Heritage is not a statutory designation in the UK, in spite of the global importance of WHSs and the duty and obligations of the UK government towards the UNESCO World Heritage Convention. On the Jurassic Coast it is the network of SSSIs, National Landscapes, the Heritage Coasts, and local plans that provide the key legal framework for the sustainable protection and management of the Site's OUV. It may be prudent and useful therefore to make sure this relationship is noted in the local plan. Within the paragraphs that set out the justification for this policy I recommend inserting an additional paragraph to note that both National Landscapes and Heritage Coasts are identified as providing legal protection and management for the Jurassic Coast WHS and its setting.
