Hello,

I'm a resident of the currently lovely village of Lympstone in East Devon and have concerns about the draft plan for the village. There are just far too many houses planned for the village and surrounding areas. I'm most concerned about the LP_Lymp_07 proposed site as this would effectively join Lympstone to Exmouth completely killing the village by making it an Exmouth suburb.

I fully understand the need for new houses in the area and could support some of the smaller proposed sites like LP_GH/ED73 or LP_GH/ED72 but not both as it would overwhelm the tiny Meeting Lane and the very dangerous junction where it meets the main road. I could also support LP_Lymp_09, LP_Lymp_10a and LP_Lymp_14.

I'm trying not to be irrational here but overall, please drop LP_Lymp_07 from consideration and be mindful of the number of houses approved for a relatively small village so as not to kill the character and friendly village feel of our community.
