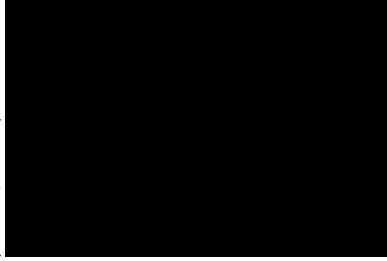

I am writing to object to the proposed planning on Strawberry Hill, Lympstone and Meeting Lane, Woodbury

1) Strawberry Hill, Lympstone - this is an old country lane only wide enough for two vehicles to pass in places, with no pavement. Traffic from Strawberry Hill development will travel down Strawberry Hill to get out onto the A376 at the Saddlers Arms because this is where the traffic lights are. The

turning out of Birch Road onto Strawberry Hill is a blind turning, added traffic would increase the danger of an accident. Also added traffic to the hill would add danger to pedestrians as cars speed down the hill, where there is no pavement.

2) Meeting Lane, Woodbury - This maybe in the parish of Woodbury, but on the other side of the road is Lymington's parish and village, with Woodbury's village miles away, so all the residents from a new development would put pressure on Lymington's school and doctors, while Woodbury can take off its amount of new housing without any impact to Woodbury parish. Again the lane is narrow, without pavements, closes when floods and this traffic would use Strawberry

Hill (as mentioned in (1)). The site would be situated next to a historical burial ground and again impact on this area, as people use this as a quiet area to sit. The huge barns built on Meeking Lane have been a back door way into allowing housing.
