

NOTICE OF ELECTION

UK Parliamentary Election for the Exmouth and Exeter East Constituency

1. An Election is to be held for a Member of Parliament to serve Exmouth and Exeter East.
2. Nomination papers can be obtained from the offices of the Acting Returning Officer, at Blackdown House, Border Road, Honiton, EX14 1EJ during the times stated below. They can also be found on our website: eastdevon.gov.uk/elections-and-registering-to-vote/uk-general-election/
3. Nomination papers must be delivered to the Acting Returning Officer, at Blackdown House, Border Road, Honiton, EX14 1EJ on any day after the date of this notice, on Monday to Friday between the hours of 10 am and 4 pm (excluding Bank Holidays) but no later than 4 pm on Friday, 7th June 2024.
4. At the same time as delivering the nomination paper, candidates must also supply a £500 deposit which must be made by the deposit of cash (legal tender).
5. If the election is contested, the poll will take place on Thursday, 4th July 2024.
6. Applications to register to vote must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by 12 midnight on Tuesday 18 June 2024. Applications can be made online: <https://www.gov.uk/register-to-vote>
7. New applications to vote by post and amendments or cancellations of existing postal votes or proxy vote arrangements must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Blackdown House, Border Road, Honiton, EX14 1EJ by 5 pm on Wednesday, 19th June 2024. 8. Applications for a Voter Authority Certificate or an Anonymous Elector's Document valid for this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by 5pm on Wednesday 26 June 2024. Applications can be made online: <https://www.gov.uk/apply-for-photo-id-voter-authority-certificate>
9. New applications to vote by proxy at this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Blackdown House, Border Road, Honiton, EX14 1EJ by 5 pm on Wednesday, 26th June 2024. Applications can be made online: <https://www.gov.uk/apply-proxy-vote>
10. Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Blackdown House, Border Road, Honiton, EX14 1EJ by 5 pm on Thursday, 4th July 2024.
