This site needs to be visited in person to fully understand the concerns. Is there any sight of the tests that have been completed regarding flooding? Level 2 SFRA has been undertaken for Otry\_10 and a sequential test completed for Strawberry Lane and Salston Barton but the results have not been published.

What happens if a site is included but it is then found to be unsuitable? Does that cause the land supply to be questioned? It was felt that additional houses would be provided through the proposed new town but there is not enough information regarding what this would entail.

Otry\_21 – there are access problems with this site and no nearby facilities without walking into town. Sustainable sites should be on the other side of town – not this side.

Ottery is a Tier 2 settlement – there is no train station and the existing ‘regular’ bus service is not regular enough for the existing residents.

Otry\_09 – water pours onto the road from this site. The Council feel it is essential that there is focus on the development of enhanced sustainable travel modes. All facilities should be accessible within an accessible distance.

A member of the public asked “What is the Council aspiring to in relation to industrial units?” The Council hasn’t discussed this but this is something that can be included in the new Neighbourhood Plan. This will be discussed once the Neighbourhood Plan review is commenced. Otry\_20 is not included in the sites for Ottery (Strategic Policy SD04 Pages 85-87) despite this being part of the Ottery St Mary parish and during the Strategic Planning Meetings only Ottery St Mary Town Council could speak in relation to this site. This site is in fact included in the Feniton section (Strategic Policy SD18 Page 98). The Council feel that this is misleading to those wishing to comment on the plan as it isn't transparent that that site is in Ottery Parish. The Council is also concerned that no numbers have been allocated how many houses could be built on this site. The proposal to put industrial units/employment to North nearer the existing houses and new houses further away to the south would mean that the new houses would be further away than the required meterage to walk to the local facilities making the site too remote. The Council are extremely concerned that this proposal involves removing an existing orchard.

Otry\_15 – would increase traffic through town. There is currently no footpath on Slade Road and there should be an improvement to the footpath infrastructure before any development takes place.
